A BILL

To amend the Food and Nutrition Act of 2008 to improve access to the food distribution program on Indian reservations, and for other purposes.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4 This Act may be cited as the “Tribal Nutrition Pro-
5 gram Administration Act of 2023”.

6 **SEC. 2. ELIMINATION OF THE ADMINISTRATIVE AND DIS-**
7 **TRIBUTION COST SHARING REQUIREMENT.**

8 Section 4(b) of the Food and Nutrition Act of 2008
9 (7 U.S.C. 2013(b)) is amended by striking paragraph (4)
10 and inserting the following:

1 “(4) ADMINISTRATIVE AND DISTRIBUTION
2 COSTS.—The Secretary shall pay 100 percent of ad-
3 ministrative costs and distribution costs on Indian
4 reservations.”.
