## A BILL

To renew the temporary suspension of duty on lanthanum phosphate phosphor, activated by cerium and terbium.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*  
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. LANTHANUM PHOSPHATE PHOSPHOR, ACTI-**  
4 **VATED BY CERIUM AND TERBIUM.**

5 (a) IN GENERAL.—Heading 9902.22.75 of the Har-  
6 monized Tariff Schedule of the United States (relating to  
7 lanthanum phosphate phosphor, activated by cerium and  
8 terbium) is amended by striking the date in the effective  
9 period column and inserting “12/31/2015”.

1       (b) EFFECTIVE DATE.—The amendment made by  
2 subsection (a) applies to goods entered, or withdrawn from  
3 warehouse for consumption, on or after the 15th day after  
4 the date of the enactment of this Act.
