3 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4 This Act may be cited as the “Helen Keller National
5 Center Reauthorization Act of 2019”.

6 **SEC. 2. HELEN KELLER NATIONAL CENTER REAUTHOR-**
7 **IZED.**

8 The first sentence of section 205(a) of the Helen Kel-
9 ler National Center Act (29 U.S.C. 1904(a)) is amended
