A BILL

To amend the Lobbying Disclosure Act of 1995 to require certain disclosures by registrants regarding exemptions under the Foreign Agents Registration Act of 1938, as amended.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

1 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

2 This Act may be cited as the “Lobbying Disclosure
3 Improvement Act”.

4 **SEC. 2. REGISTRANT DISCLOSURE REGARDING FOREIGN**
5 **AGENT REGISTRATION EXEMPTION.**

6 Section 4(b) of the Lobbying Disclosure Act of 1995
7 (2 U.S.C. 1603(b)) is amended—

8 (1) in paragraph (6), by striking “; and” and
9 inserting a semicolon;

10 (2) in paragraph (7), by striking the period at
11 the end and inserting “; and”; and

12 (3) by adding at the end the following:

13 “(8) a statement as to whether the registrant is
14 exempt under section 3(h) of the Foreign Agents
15 Registration Act of 1938, as amended (22 U.S.C.
16 613(h)).”.
