## A BILL

To amend the Adam Walsh Child Protection and Safety Act of 2006 to reauthorize the Fugitive Safe Surrender Program.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*  
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4 This Act may be cited as the “Fugitive Safe Sur-  
5 render Reauthorization Act of 2023”.

6 **SEC. 2. FUGITIVE SAFE SURRENDER PROGRAM.**

7 Section 632(c) of the Adam Walsh Child Protection  
8 and Safety Act of 2006 (34 U.S.C. 20989(c)) is amended

1 by striking paragraphs (1) through (3) and inserting the  
2 following:

3           “(1) \$10,000,000 for fiscal year 2024;

4           “(2) \$10,000,000 for fiscal year 2025;

5           “(3) \$10,000,000 for fiscal year 2026; and

6           “(4) \$10,000,000 for fiscal year 2027.”.
