A BILL

To suspend temporarily the duty on certain catalytic converter mats of glass fibers.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. CERTAIN CATALYTIC CONVERTER MATS OF**
4 **GLASS FIBERS.**

5 (a) IN GENERAL.—Subchapter II of chapter 99 of
6 the Harmonized Tariff Schedule of the United States is
7 amended by inserting in numerical sequence the following
8 new heading:

“	9902.01.00	Catalytic converter mounting and thermal insulation mats of at least 40% per weight R-glass fiber containing 60% silica, 19% alumina, 10% calcium oxide, and 10% magnesium oxide (within $\pm 5\%$ per weight tolerance), said mat being 3 mm or more in thickness, in rolls, designed for diesel commercial vehicles (provided for in subheading 7019.31.00)	Free	No change	No change	On or before 12/31/2015	”.

1 (b) **EFFECTIVE DATE.**—The amendment made by
2 subsection (a) applies with respect to goods entered, or
3 withdrawn from warehouse for consumption, on or after
4 the 15th day after the date of the enactment of this Act.
