A BILL

To amend the Community Development Banking and Financial Institutions Act of 1994 to increase transparency and accountability regarding the operations of the Community Development Financial Institutions Fund.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4 This Act may be cited as the “CDFI Fund Trans-
5 parency Act”.

6 **SEC. 2. REQUIREMENT TO TESTIFY.**

7 Section 104(b) of the Community Development
8 Banking and Financial Institutions Act of 1994 (12

1 U.S.C. 4703(b)) is amended by adding to the end the fol-
2 lowing:

3 “(5) ANNUAL TESTIMONY.—The Secretary of
4 the Treasury (or a designee of the Secretary) shall,
5 at the discretion of the chairman of the Committee
6 on Banking, Housing, and Urban Affairs of the Sen-
7 ate and chairman of the Committee on Financial
8 Services of the House of Representatives, annually
9 testify before such committees (or a subcommittee of
10 such committees) regarding the operations of the
11 Fund during the previous fiscal year.”.
