A BILL

To suspend temporarily the duty on certain laminated rolled filmstock.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. CERTAIN LAMINATED ROLLED FILMSTOCK.**

4 (a) IN GENERAL.—Subchapter II of chapter 99 of
5 the Harmonized Tariff Schedule of the United States is
6 amended by inserting in numerical sequence the following
7 new heading:

“	9902.01.00	Laminated film of polyethylene, in rolls, printed, with an overall thickness of approximately 0.114 mm or more but not over 0.185 mm (provided for in subheading 3926.10.00)	Free	No change	No change	On or before 12/31/2011	”.

1 (b) EFFECTIVE DATE.—The amendment made by
2 subsection (a) applies to goods entered, or withdrawn from
3 warehouse for consumption, on or after the 15th day after
4 the date of the enactment of this Act.
