A BILL

To reauthorize the National Flood Insurance Program.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4 This Act may be cited as the “NFIP Extension Act
5 of 2021”.

6 **SEC. 2. REAUTHORIZATION OF NATIONAL FLOOD INSUR-**
7 **ANCE PROGRAM.**

8 (a) FINANCING.—Section 1309(a) of the National
9 Flood Insurance Act of 1968 (42 U.S.C. 4016(a)) is
10 amended by striking “September 30, 2021” and inserting
11 “September 30, 2022”.

1 (b) PROGRAM EXPIRATION.—Section 1319 of the Na-
2 tional Flood Insurance Act of 1968 (42 U.S.C. 4026) is
3 amended by striking “September 30, 2021” and inserting
4 “September 30, 2022”.

5 (c) RETROACTIVE EFFECTIVE DATE.—If this Act is
6 enacted after September 30, 2021, the amendments made
7 by subsections (a) and (b) shall take effect as if enacted
8 on September 30, 2021.

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
