- 3 (b) References.—During the period in which the

- 5 any reference in a law, map, regulation, document, paper,
- 6 or other record of the United States to that building shall
- 7 be deemed to be a reference to the "Ralph Regula Federal
- 8 Office Building and Courthouse".
