A BILL

To amend the Internal Revenue Code of 1986 to increase the deduction for certain expenses of elementary and secondary school teachers.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4 This Act may be cited as the “Educators Expense
5 Deduction Modernization Act of 2023”.

1 **SEC. 2. INCREASE IN DEDUCTION FOR CERTAIN EXPENSES**
2 **OF ELEMENTARY AND SECONDARY SCHOOL**
3 **TEACHERS.**

4 (a) **IN GENERAL.**—Section 62(a)(2)(D) of the Inter-
5 nal Revenue Code of 1986 is amended—

6 (1) by striking “ELEMENTARY AND SECONDARY
7 SCHOOL TEACHERS” in the heading and inserting
8 “ELIGIBLE EDUCATORS”, and

9 (2) by striking “\$250” and inserting “\$1,000”.

10 (b) **CONFORMING AMENDMENTS.**—Section 62(d)(3)
11 of the Internal Revenue Code of 1986 is amended—

12 (1) by striking “2015” and inserting “2023”,

13 (2) by striking “\$250” and inserting “\$1,000”,

14 and

15 (3) by striking “calendar year 2014” and in-
16 serting “calendar year 2022”.

17 (c) **EFFECTIVE DATE.**—The amendments made by
18 this section shall apply with respect to taxable years begin-
19 ning December 31, 2022.

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
