1 SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.

2 This Act may be cited as the "Train More Nurses3 Act".

4 SEC. 2. REVIEW OF AND REPORT ON PROGRAMS SUP-5 PORTING THE NURSING WORKFORCE.

6 The Secretary of Health and Human Services and the7 Secretary of Labor, jointly, shall—

8 (1) conduct a review of all grant programs car-9 ried out by the Department of Health and Human 10 Services or the Department of Labor that support 11 the nurse workforce; and

(2) not later than 1 year after the date of enactment of this Act, submit to Congress a report on
the review under paragraph (1) that includes recommendations for changes to such grant programs
to improve upon the goals of—

- 17 (A) increasing nurse faculty, particularly18 in underserved areas;
- (B) providing pathways for nurses who
 have more than 10 years of clinical experience
 to become faculty at schools of nursing; and

 (C) encouraging and increasing the nursing pipeline through pathways for licensed practical nurses to become registered nurses.
