Mr. GRASSLEY (for himself and Mr. LEAHY) introduced the following bill; which was read twice and referred to the Committee on Rules and Administration

A BILL

To reauthorize the sound recording and film preservation programs of the Library of Congress, and for other purposes.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4 This Act may be cited as the “Library of Congress
5 Sound Recording and Film Preservation Programs Reau-
6 thorization Act of 2016”.

7 **SEC. 2. SOUND RECORDING PRESERVATION PROGRAMS.**

8 (a) NATIONAL RECORDING PRESERVATION
9 BOARD.—Section 133 of the National Recording Preser-
10 vation Act of 2000 (2 U.S.C. 1743) is amended by striking

1 “through fiscal year 2016” and inserting “through fiscal
2 year 2026”.

3 (b) NATIONAL RECORDING PRESERVATION FOUNDA-
4 TION.—

5 (1) REAUTHORIZATION.—Section 152411(a) of
6 title 36, United States Code, is amended by striking
7 “through fiscal year 2016 an amount not to exceed”
8 and inserting “through fiscal year 2026 an amount
9 not to exceed the lesser of \$750,000 or”.

10 (2) NUMBER OF MEMBERS OF BOARD OF DI-
11 RECTORS.—Section 152403(b)(2) of title 36, United
12 States Code, is amended—

13 (A) in subparagraph (A), by striking “nine
14 directors” and inserting “12 directors”; and

15 (B) in subparagraph (C), by striking “six
16 directors” each place it appears and inserting
17 “8 directors”.

18 **SEC. 3. FILM PRESERVATION PROGRAMS.**

19 (a) NATIONAL FILM PRESERVATION BOARD.—Sec-
20 tion 112 of the National Film Preservation Act of 1996
21 (2 U.S.C. 179v) is amended by striking “through fiscal
22 year 2016” and inserting “through fiscal year 2026”.

23 (b) NATIONAL FILM PRESERVATION FOUNDATION.—
24 Section 151711(a)(1)(C) of title 36, United States Code,

1 is amended by striking “through 2016” and inserting
2 “through 2026”.
