3 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4 This Act may be cited as the “USPS Fairness Act”.

5 **SEC. 2. REPEAL OF REQUIRED PREPAYMENT OF FUTURE**
6 **POSTAL SERVICE RETIREMENT BENEFITS.**

7 Subsection (d) of section 8909a of title 5, United
