Mr. CRUZ introduced the following bill; which was read twice and referred to
the Committee on Foreign Relations

A BILL

To require a report on imprisonment of political prisoners
in China.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. REPORT ON IMPRISONMENT OF POLITICAL**
4 **PRISONERS IN CHINA.**

5 (a) IN GENERAL.—Not later than 180 days after the
6 date of the enactment of this Act, the Secretary of State
7 shall submit to the relevant congressional committees a
8 report that includes—

9 (1) the names of officials in the People’s Re-
10 public of China responsible for the imprisonment of
11 political prisoners;

1 (2) a determination whether the officials identi-
2 fied in paragraph (1) are designated under the Glob-
3 al Magnitsky Human Rights Accountability Act
4 (subtitle F of title XII of Public Law 114–328); and

5 (3) if they are not designated, a justification for
6 why not.

7 (b) DEFINITIONS.—In this section—

8 (1) the term “official” means—

9 (A) any state official at the local, provin-
10 cial, or national level in China;

11 (B) any member of the Communist Party
12 of China; or

13 (C) any member of the People’s Liberation
14 Army; and

15 (2) the term “relevant congressional commit-
16 tees” means the Committee on Foreign Relations of
17 the Senate and the Committee on Foreign Affairs of
18 the House of Representatives.
