To extend the sunset of the Iran Sanctions Act of 1996 in order to effectuate the Joint Comprehensive Plan of Action in guaranteeing that all nuclear material in Iran remains in peaceful activities.

2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

1 **SECTION 1. EXTENSION OF SUNSET OF IRAN SANCTIONS**
2 **ACT OF 1996 IN ORDER TO EFFECTUATE THE**
3 **JOINT COMPREHENSIVE PLAN OF ACTION IN**
4 **GUARANTEEING THAT ALL NUCLEAR MATE-**
5 **RIAL IN IRAN REMAINS IN PEACEFUL ACTIVI-**
6 **TIES.**

7 Subsection (b) of section 13 of the Iran Sanctions
8 Act of 1996 (Public Law 104–172; 50 U.S.C. 1701 note)
9 is amended to read as follows:

10 “(b) SUNSET.—This Act shall cease to be effective
11 on the date on which the President certifies to Congress
12 that the Director General of the International Atomic En-
13 ergy Agency has reached a broader conclusion (as defined
14 by the Director General) that all nuclear material in Iran
15 remains in peaceful activities.”.
