3 **SECTION 1. REVOCATION OF WAIVER DETERMINATION**
4 **WITH RESPECT TO CERTAIN IRAN SANC-**
5 **TIONS.**

6 (a) IN GENERAL.—On and after the date of the en-
7 actment of this Act, the waiver determination issued by
8 the Secretary of State pursuant the provisions of law spec-

1 ified in subsection (b) and submitted to Congress on Sep-
2 tember 11, 2023, shall have no force or effect.

3 (b) PROVISIONS OF LAW SPECIFIED.—The provisions
4 of law specified in this subsection are—

5 (1) section 1245(d)(5) of the National Defense
6 Authorization Act for Fiscal Year 2012 (22 U.S.C.
7 8513a(d)(5)); or

8 (2) section 1244(i) or 1247(f) of the Iran Free-
9 dom and Counter-Proliferation Act of 2012 (22
10 U.S.C. 8803(i) and 8806(f)).
