To direct the Secretary of the Interior to conduct studies of natural soundscape preservation in the National Park Service.

- 1 Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-

- 3 SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.
- 4 This Act may be cited as the "Silence Helps Us Hear
- 5 Act of 2010".
- 6 SEC. 2. DEFINITIONS.
- 7 In this Act:
- 8 (1) ADMINISTRATOR.—The term "Adminis-
- 9 trator" means the Administrator of the Federal
- 10 Aviation Administration.

2	the Secretary of the Interior, acting through the Di-

4	SEC. 3. STUDIES OF NATURAL SOUNDSCAPE PRESERVA-
5	TION.
6	(a) Study of Least Degraded National Park
7	SERVICE NATURAL SOUNDSCAPES.—
8	(1) In General.—The Secretary shall conduct
9	a study to identify National Park Service natural
10	soundscape values and resources, as defined by poli-
11	cies 4.9 and 8.2 of the 2006 Management Policies
12	of the National Park Service.
13	(2) Identification of lease degraded
14	SOUNDSCAPES.—In conducting the study under
15	paragraph (1), the Secretary shall analyze and iden-
16	tify National Park Service natural soundscapes that
17	have been the least degraded by—
18	(A) unnatural sounds; and
19	(B) undesirable sounds cause by humans.
20	(3) TECHNICAL ASSISTANCE.—To the extent
21	that the Secretary has identified aviation or aircraft
22	noise as 1 of the sources of natural soundscapes
23	degradation, the Secretary of Transportation, acting
24	through the Administrator, shall provide technical

- 1 assistance to the Secretary in carrying out the study 2 under paragraph (1). 3 (b) STUDY OFPreservation NATURAL OF Soundscape Resources.—To the extent that the Secretary has identified aviation or aircraft noise as 1 of the 5 6 sources of National Park Service natural soundscapes degradation, the Secretary, in coordination with the Secretary of Transportation (acting through the Administrator), 8 shall conduct a study to identify methods to preserve the 10 National Park Service natural soundscapes that have been the least degraded by— 11 12 (1) unnatural sounds; and 13 (2) undesirable sounds caused by humans. 14 SEC. 4. REPORT. 15 Not later than 1 year after the date of enactment of this Act, the Secretary shall submit to Congress a re-16 port that— 17
- 18 (1) describes the results of the studies con-
- 19 ducted under subsections (a) and (b) of section 3;

- 21 (2) includes any recommendations that the Sec-
- 22 retary determines to be appropriate.
