Mr. CORNYN (for himself and Mr. KING) introduced the following bill; which was read twice and referred to the Committee on Foreign Relations

A BILL

To express the sense of Congress on interoperability with Taiwan.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. SENSE OF CONGRESS ON INTEROPERABILITY**
4 **WITH TAIWAN.**

5 It is the sense of Congress that, consistent with the
6 Taiwan Relations Act (Public Law 96–8; 22 U.S.C. 3301
7 et seq.) and the Six Assurances, the United States should
8 seek to support the goals of—

9 (1) improving asymmetric defense capabilities
10 of Taiwan;

1 (2) bolstering deterrence to preserve peace, se-
2 curity, and stability across the Taiwan Strait; and

3 (3) deepening interoperability with Taiwan in
4 defense capabilities, including in—

5 (A) maritime and air domain awareness;

6 and

7 (B) integrated air and missile defense sys-
8 tems.
