A BILL

To permit the Scipio A. Jones Post Office in Little Rock, Arkansas, to accept and display a portrait of Scipio A. Jones, and for other purposes.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. SCIPIO A. JONES POST OFFICE PORTRAIT.**

4 (a) IN GENERAL.—The postmaster of the Scipio A.
5 Jones Post Office, located at 1700 Main Street in Little
6 Rock, Arkansas, may accept and display, in the lobby of
7 such Post Office, a painting, by artist Wade Hampton,
8 of a portrait of Scipio A. Jones.

1 (b) COSTS; GIFTS.—The United States Postal Serv-
2 ice shall not be responsible for any costs of carrying out
3 subsection (a), including the costs of displaying the paint-
4 ing. The postmaster referred to in such subsection is au-
5 thorized to accept on behalf of the Government the paint-
6 ing and any services necessary to display the painting.

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
