Mr. MERKLEY (for himself, Mr. MARKEY, Ms. WARREN, Mr. WYDEN, Mr. BLUMENTHAL, Mr. WELCH, Mr. SANDERS, and Mr. MENENDEZ) introduced the following bill; which was read twice and referred to the Committee on Energy and Natural Resources

A BILL

To prohibit drilling in the Arctic Ocean.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4 This Act may be cited as the “Stop Arctic Ocean
5 Drilling Act of 2023”.

6 **SEC. 2. PROHIBITION OF OIL AND GAS LEASING IN ARCTIC**
7 **AREAS OF THE OUTER CONTINENTAL SHELF.**

8 Section 8 of the Outer Continental Shelf Lands Act
9 (43 U.S.C. 1337) is amended by adding at the end the
10 following:

1 “(q) PROHIBITION OF OIL AND GAS LEASING IN
2 ARCTIC AREAS OF THE OUTER CONTINENTAL SHELF.—

3 “(1) DEFINITION OF ARCTIC.—In this sub-
4 section, the term ‘Arctic’ has the meaning given the
5 term in section 112 of the Arctic Research and Pol-
6 icy Act of 1984 (15 U.S.C. 4111).

7 “(2) PROHIBITION.—Notwithstanding any other
8 provision of this Act or any other law, the Secretary
9 of the Interior shall not issue or extend a lease or
10 any other authorization for the exploration, develop-
11 ment, or production of oil, natural gas, or any other
12 mineral on Arctic areas of the outer Continental
13 Shelf.”.
