To designate the J. Marvin Jones Federal Building and United States Courthouse in Amarillo, Texas, as the “J. Marvin Jones Federal Building and Mary Lou Robinson United States Courthouse”.

2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. J. MARVIN JONES FEDERAL BUILDING AND**
4 **MARY LOU ROBINSON UNITED STATES**
5 **COURTHOUSE.**

6 (a) DESIGNATION.—The J. Marvin Jones Federal
7 Building and United States Courthouse located at 205 SE
8 5th Ave., Amarillo, Texas, shall be known and designated

1 as the “J. Marvin Jones Federal Building and Mary Lou
2 Robinson United States Courthouse”.

3 (b) REFERENCES.—Any reference in a law, map, reg-
4 ulation, document, paper, or other record of the United
5 States to the Federal building and United States court-
6 house referred to in subsection (a) shall be deemed to be
7 a reference to the “J. Marvin Jones Federal Building and
8 Mary Lou Robinson United States Courthouse”.

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
