A BILL

To direct the Secretary of Homeland Security to notify air carriers and security screening personnel of the Transportation Security Administration of the guidelines of the Administration regarding permitting baby formula, breast milk, and juice on aircraft, and for other purposes.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4 This Act may be cited as the “Bottles and Breast-
5 feeding Equipment Screening Act”.

1 **SEC. 2. TSA SECURITY SCREENING GUIDELINES FOR BABY**
2 **FORMULA, BREAST MILK, AND JUICE ON AIR-**
3 **CRAFT; TRAINING ON SPECIAL PROCEDURES.**

4 Not later than 90 days after the date of the enact-
5 ment of this Act, the Secretary of Homeland Security
6 shall—

7 (1) notify air carriers and security screening
8 personnel of the Transportation Security Adminis-
9 tration of the guidelines of the Administration re-
10 garding permitting baby formula, breast milk, and
11 juice on aircraft under the Administration’s guide-
12 lines known as the 3–1–1 Liquids Rule Exemption;
13 and

14 (2) in training procedures for security screening
15 personnel of the Administration, include training on
16 all special procedures under the Administration’s
17 travel guidelines.

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
