A BILL

To restrict funding for the Preparatory Commission for the Comprehensive Nuclear-Test-Ban Treaty Organization, and for other purposes.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. RESTRICTION ON FUNDING FOR THE PRE-**
4 **PARATORY COMMISSION FOR THE COM-**
5 **PREHENSIVE NUCLEAR-TEST-BAN TREATY**
6 **ORGANIZATION.**

7 (a) STATEMENT OF POLICY.—Congress declares that
8 United Nations Security Council Resolution 2310 (Sep-
9 tember 23, 2016) does not obligate the United States or
10 impose an obligation on the United States to refrain from

1 actions that would run counter to the object and purpose
2 of the Comprehensive Nuclear-Test-Ban Treaty.

3 (b) RESTRICTION ON FUNDING.—

4 (1) IN GENERAL.—No United States funds may
5 be made available to the Preparatory Commission
6 for the Comprehensive Nuclear-Test-Ban Treaty Or-
7 ganization.

8 (2) EXCEPTION.—The restriction under para-
9 graph (1) shall not apply with respect to the avail-
10 ability of United States funds for the Comprehensive
11 Nuclear-Test-Ban Treaty Organization's Inter-
12 national Monitoring System.
