A BILL

For the relief of Marco Antonio Sanchez.

1 Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives of the United States of America in Congress assembled, 2 3 SECTION 1. PERMANENT RESIDENT STATUS FOR MARCO 4 ANTONIO SANCHEZ. 5 (a) IN GENERAL.—Notwithstanding subsections (a) 6 and (b) of section 201 of the Immigration and Nationality 7 Act (8 U.S.C. 1151), Marco Antonio Sanchez shall be eli-8 gible for an immigrant visa or for adjustment of status 9 to that of an alien lawfully admitted for permanent residence upon filing an application for issuance of an immi-10 grant visa under section 204 of that Act (8 U.S.C. 1154) 11 12 or for adjustment of status to lawful permanent resident.

1 (b) ADJUSTMENT OF STATUS.—If Marco Antonio 2 Sanchez enters the United States before the filing deadline 3 set forth in subsection (c), Marco Antonio Sanchez shall 4 be considered to have entered and remained lawfully in 5 the United States and shall be eligible for adjustment to lawful permanent resident status under section 245 of the 6 7 Immigration and Nationality Act (8 U.S.C. 1255) as of 8 the date of the enactment of this Act.

9 (c) Application and Payment of Fees.—Sub-10 sections (a) and (b) shall apply only if the application for issuance of an immigrant visa or the application for ad-11 12 justment of status is filed with appropriate fees not later 13 than 2 years after the date of the enactment of this Act. 14 (d) REDUCTION OF IMMIGRANT VISA NUMBERS.— 15 Upon the granting of an immigrant visa or lawful permanent resident status to Marco Antonio Sanchez, the Sec-16 17 retary of State shall instruct the proper officer to reduce by one, during the current or next following fiscal year, 18 19 the total number of immigrant visas that are made avail-20able to natives of the country of birth of Marco Antonio 21 Sanchez under section 202(a)(2) of the Immigration and 22 Nationality Act (8 U.S.C. 1152(a)(2)).
