A BILL

To require the Surgeon General of the Public Health Service to submit to Congress a report on the health effects of new psychoactive substances (including synthetic drugs) use.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4 This Act may be cited as the “Synthetic Drug Aware-
5 ness Act of 2018”.

1 **SEC. 2. REPORT ON EFFECTS ON PUBLIC HEALTH OF SYN-**
2 **THETIC DRUG USE.**

3 (a) IN GENERAL.—Not later than 3 years after the
4 date of the enactment of this Act, the Surgeon General
5 of the Public Health Service shall submit to Congress a
6 report on the health effects of new psychoactive substances
7 (including synthetic drugs) used since January 2010 by
8 persons who are at least 12 years of age but no more than
9 18 years of age.

10 (b) NEW PSYCHOACTIVE SUBSTANCE DEFINED.—
11 For purposes of subsection (a), the term “new
12 psychoactive substance” means a controlled substance
13 analogue (as defined in section 102(32) of the Controlled
14 Substances Act (21 U.S.C. 802(32))).
