## A BILL

To amend title 10, United States Code, to improve access to mental health care counselors under the TRICARE program, and for other purposes.

- 3 (c) REQUIREMENTS FOR MENTAL HEALTH COUN-
- 4 SELORS PRACTICING UNDER TRICARE.—For purposes
- 5 of practicing as a mental health counselor under the
- 6 TRICARE program pursuant to the amendments made by
- 7 subsections (a) and (b), an individual shall meet the fol-
- 8 lowing:
- 9 (1) The individual shall possess a masters de-
- gree or higher level degree in counseling from a pro-
- gram in mental health counseling or clinical mental
- health counseling that is accredited by the Council
- for Accreditation of Counseling and Related Edu-
- 14 cational Programs.
- 15 (2) The individual shall possess a State license
- in mental health counseling at the "clinical" or high-
- er level or at the highest level available in States
- that have tiered licensing schemes.
- 19 (3) The individual shall have passed the Na-

- 22 (4) The individual shall have a well-defined
- scope of practice (as determining utilizing a system-

- 3 (d) Reports on Implementation.—
- 4 (1) INITIAL REPORT.—Not later than 180 days
  5 after the date of the enactment of this Act, the Sec6 retary of Defense shall submit to Congress a report
  7 on the implementation of this section and the
  8 amendments made by this section.
- 9 (2) UPDATED REPORT.—Not later than one 10 year after the date of the enactment of this Act, the 11 Secretary shall submit to Congress an update to the 12 report submitted under paragraph (1).
- 13 (e) TRICARE PROGRAM DEFINED.—In this section, 14 the term "TRICARE program" has the meaning given 15 that term in section 1072(7) of title 10, United States 16 Code.

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
