## AN ACT

To require limitations on prescribed burns.

- 1 Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-
- 2 tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,

### 1 SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.

- This Act may be cited as the "Prescribed Burn Ap-
- 3 proval Act of 2016".
- 4 SEC. 2. DEFINITIONS.
- 5 In this Act:
- 6 (1) National fire danger rating sys-
- 7 TEM.—The term "national fire danger rating sys-
- 8 tem" means the national system used to provide a
- 9 measure of fire danger according to a range of low
- to moderate to high to very high to extreme.
- 11 (2) Prescribed Burn.—The term "prescribed
- burn" means a planned fire intentionally ignited.
- 13 (3) Secretary.—The term "Secretary" means
- the Secretary of Agriculture, acting through the
- 15 Chief of the Forest Service.

### 16 SEC. 3. LIMITATIONS ON PRESCRIBED BURNS.

- 17 (a) In General.—Except as provided in subsection
- 18 (b), the Secretary shall not authorize a prescribed burn
- 19 on Forest Service land if, for the county or contiguous
- 20 county in which the land is located, the national fire dan-
- 21 ger rating system indicates an extreme fire danger level.
- 22 (b) Exception.—The Secretary may authorize a
- 23 prescribed burn under a condition described in subsection
- 24 (a) if the Secretary coordinates with the applicable State
- 25 government and local fire officials.

1	(c) Report.—At the end of each fiscal year, the Sec-
2	retary shall submit to Congress a report describing—
3	(1) the number and locations of prescribed
4	burns during that fiscal year; and
5	(2) each prescribed burn during that fiscal year
6	that was authorized by the Secretary pursuant to
7	subsection (b).
