3 **SECTION 1. GUIDANCE ON DEVELOPING NON-ADDICTIVE**
4 **MEDICAL PRODUCTS TO TREAT PAIN OR AD-**
5 **DICTION.**

6 Not later than 1 year after the date of enactment
7 of this Act, the Secretary of Health and Human Services
8 shall issue draft guidance under section 3001(b) of the
9 SUPPORT for Patients and Communities Act (21 U.S.C.

1 355 note) to address non-addictive analgesics for chronic
2 pain, including the information required to be included in
3 guidance documents under paragraphs (1) through (4) of
4 such section 3001(b).
