A BILL

To reauthorize the Erie Canalway National Heritage Corridor, and for other purposes.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4 This Act may be cited as the “Erie Canalway Na-
5 tional Heritage Reauthorization Act”.

6 **SEC. 2. REAUTHORIZATION OF THE ERIE CANALWAY NA-**
7 **TIONAL HERITAGE CORRIDOR.**

8 (a) AUTHORIZATION OF APPROPRIATIONS.—Section
9 810(a)(1) of the Erie Canalway National Heritage Cor-
10 ridor Act (54 U.S.C. 320101 note; Public Law 106–554;

1 114 Stat. 2763A–303; 131 Stat. 461; 133 Stat. 2714),
2 as amended by section 119(m) of division G of the Consoli-
3 dated Appropriations Act, 2022, is amended by striking
4 “\$16,000,000” and inserting “\$18,000,000”.

5 (b) REAUTHORIZATION.—Section 811 of the Erie
6 Canalway National Heritage Corridor Act (54 U.S.C.
7 320101 note; Public Law 106–554; 114 Stat. 2763A–295;
8 128 Stat. 3802), as amended by section 119(j) of division
9 G of the Consolidated Appropriations Act, 2022, is
10 amended by striking “2023” and inserting “2037”.

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
