## A BILL

To repeal certain amendments made to rule 41 of the  
Federal Rules of Criminal Procedure.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*  
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4 This Act may be cited as the “Stopping Mass Hack-  
5 ing Act”.

6 **SEC. 2. CRIMINAL PROCEDURE RULES.**

7 (a) IN GENERAL.—Effective on the date of enact-  
8 ment of this Act, rule 41 of the Federal Rules of Criminal  
9 Procedure is amended to read as it read on November 30,  
10 2016.

1       (b) APPLICABILITY.—Notwithstanding the amend-  
2 ment made by subsection (a), for any warrant issued  
3 under rule 41 of the Federal Rules of Criminal Procedure  
4 during the period beginning on December 1, 2016, and  
5 ending on the date of enactment of this Act, such rule  
6 41, as it was in effect on the date on which the warrant  
7 was issued, shall apply with respect to the warrant.
