To designate the visitor center for the First State National Historical Park to be located at the Sheriff's House in New Castle, Delaware, as the "Thomas R. Carper Visitor Center".

3 **SECTION 1. DESIGNATION OF THE VISITOR CENTER FOR**
4 **THE FIRST STATE NATIONAL HISTORICAL**
5 **PARK IN NEW CASTLE, DELAWARE, AS THE**
6 **"THOMAS R. CARPER VISITOR CENTER".**

7 (a) DESIGNATION.—The visitor center for the First
8 State National Historical Park to be located at the Sher-

1 iff's House in New Castle, Delaware, or any successor to
2 that visitor center that is constructed after the date of
3 enactment of this Act and serves as the primary visitor
4 center for the First State National Historical Park, shall
5 be known and designated as the "Thomas R. Carper Vis-
6 itor Center".

7 (b) REFERENCES.—Any reference in a law, map, reg-
8 ulation, document, paper, or other record of the United
9 States to the visitor center referred to in subsection (a)
10 shall be deemed to be a reference to the "Thomas R. Car-
11 per Visitor Center".
