A BILL

To redesignate the Cottonwood Visitor Center at Joshua Tree National Park as the “Senator Dianne Feinstein Visitor Center”.

2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. REDESIGNATION OF THE COTTONWOOD VIS-**
4 **ITOR CENTER AT JOSHUA TREE NATIONAL**
5 **PARK AS THE “SENATOR DIANNE FEINSTEIN**
6 **VISITOR CENTER”.**

7 (a) REDESIGNATION.—The Cottonwood Visitor Cen-
8 ter at Joshua Tree National Park shall be known and des-
9 ignated as the “Senator Dianne Feinstein Visitor Center”.

1 (b) REFERENCES.—Any reference in a law, map, reg-
2 ulation, document, paper, or other record of the United
3 States to the visitor center referred to in subsection (a)
4 shall be deemed to be a reference to the “Senator Dianne
5 Feinstein Visitor Center”.
