A BILL

To amend the Water Resources Development Act of 1992 to provide for environmental infrastructure in Columbus, Henry, and Clayton Counties, Georgia.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4 This Act may be cited as the “Georgia Stormwater
5 Management Act”.

1 **SEC. 2. COLUMBUS, HENRY, AND CLAYTON COUNTIES,**
2 **GEORGIA.**

3 Section 219(f) of the Water Resources Development
4 Act of 1992 (106 Stat. 4835; 113 Stat. 334; 136 Stat.
5 3808) is amended by adding at the end the following:

6 “(406) COLUMBUS, HENRY, AND CLAYTON
7 COUNTIES, GEORGIA.—\$10,000,000 for environ-
8 mental infrastructure, including water and waste-
9 water infrastructure (including stormwater manage-
10 ment), Columbus, Henry, and Clayton Counties,
11 Georgia.”.
