A BILL

To establish the Southern Border Wall Construction Fund and to transfer unobligated amounts from the Coronavirus State and local fiscal recovery funds to such Fund to construct and maintain physical barriers along the southern border.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4 This Act may be cited as the “Build the Wall Act
5 of 2024”.

1 **SEC. 2. SOUTHERN BORDER WALL CONSTRUCTION FUND.**

2 (a) ESTABLISHMENT.—There is established in the
3 general fund of the Treasury a separate account, which
4 shall be known as the “Southern Border Wall Construc-
5 tion Fund” (referred to in this section as the “Fund”).

6 (b) DEPOSITS.—Notwithstanding any other provision
7 of law, there shall be immediately deposited into the Fund
8 all of the unobligated amounts in the Coronavirus State
9 and local fiscal recovery funds established under sections
10 602 and 603 of the Social Security Act (42 U.S.C. 802
11 and 803).

12 (c) USE OF FUNDS.—Amounts in the Fund shall be
13 used by the Secretary of Homeland Security to construct
14 and maintain physical barriers along the southern inter-
15 national border of the United States.
