A BILL

To waive affiliation rules under the paycheck protection program for Tribal business concerns with the same employer identification number, and for other purposes.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4 This Act may be cited as the “Tribal Business Access
5 to PPP Act”.

1 **SEC. 2. WAIVER OF AFFILIATION RULES UNDER THE PAY-**
2 **CHECK PROTECTION PROGRAM FOR TRIBAL**
3 **BUSINESS CONCERNS WITH SAME EIN.**

4 Section 7(a)(36)(D) of the Small Business Act (15
5 U.S.C. 636(a)(36)(D)) is amended—

6 (1) in clause (v), by striking “, veterans organi-
7 zation, or Tribal business concern” and inserting “or
8 veterans organization”; and

9 (2) by adding at the end the following:

10 “(vii) NO AFFILIATION BETWEEN
11 TRIBAL BUSINESS CONCERNS BASED ON
12 SHARED EIN.—During the covered period,
13 for purposes of determining eligibility for a
14 covered loan, affiliation shall not be found
15 under section 121.103 of title 13, Code of
16 Federal Regulations, or any successor reg-
17 ulation, between Tribal business concerns
18 described in section 31(b)(2)(C) based
19 solely on a shared employer identification
20 number.”.
