A BILL

To require the Secretary of Health and Human Services to collect and disseminate information about pharmaceutical affordability assistance programs.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4 This Act may be cited as the “INsulin For Our Re-
5 curring Medical Needs Act” or the “INFORM Act”.

6 **SEC. 2. COMPILATION OF INFORMATION ABOUT PHARMA-**
7 **CEUTICAL AFFORDABILITY ASSISTANCE PRO-**
8 **GRAMS.**

9 The Secretary of Health and Human Services shall—

1 (1) compile information on publicly available
2 pharmaceutical affordability assistance programs, in-
3 cluding for insulin, and including any such programs
4 administered by pharmaceutical manufacturers or by
5 nonprofit entities;

6 (2) display the information described in para-
7 graph (1) in an easily digestible format on the public
8 website of the Department of Health and Human
9 Services; and

10 (3) distribute pamphlets, brochures, and other
11 printed materials containing such information to
12 health facilities, including community health centers,
13 medical clinics, pharmacies, and hospitals.

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
