A BILL

To modify the age requirement for the Student Incentive
Payment Program of the State maritime academies.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

1 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

2 This Act may be cited as the “Changing Age-Deter-
3 mined Eligibility To Student Incentive Payments Act” or
4 the “CADETS Act”.

5 **SEC. 2. AGE REQUIREMENT FOR THE STUDENT INCENTIVE**
6 **PAYMENT PROGRAM OF THE STATE MARI-**
7 **TIME ACADEMIES.**

8 Section 51509 of title 46, United States Code, is
9 amended by adding at the end the following:

10 “(i) AGE REQUIREMENT.—The Secretary may make
11 an agreement under this section only with a qualified stu-
12 dent who will meet the age requirement for enlistment *or*
13 *commission* in the Navy Reserve at the time of graduation
14 from the academy.”.
