Mr. VITTER introduced the following bill; which was read twice and referred to the Committee on the Judiciary

A BILL

To amend chapter 44 of title 18, United States Code, to modernize the process by which interstate firearms transactions are conducted by Federal firearms licensees.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4 This Act may be cited as the “Firearms Transfer Im-
5 provement Act”.

6 **SEC. 2. AUTHORITY TO CONDUCT INTERSTATE FIREARMS**
7 **TRANSACTIONS.**

8 (a) FIREARMS DISPOSITIONS.—Section 922(b)(3) of
9 title 18, United States Code, is amended—

1 (1) by striking “rifle or shotgun” and inserting
2 “firearm”; and

3 (2) in subparagraph (A)—

4 (A) by striking “located” and inserting
5 “located or temporarily located”;

6 (B) by striking “both such States” and in-
7 serting “the State in which the transfer is con-
8 ducted”; and

9 (C) by striking “both States” and inserting
10 “the State in which the transfer is conducted”.

11 (b) DEALER LOCATION.—Section 923(j) is amend-
12 ed—

13 (1) in the first sentence, by striking “, and such
14 location is in the State which is specified on the li-
15 cense”;

16 (2) in the last sentence, by striking ““curios
17 and relics’””; and

18 (3) by adding at the end the following: “A li-
19 censee may conduct firearms transfers and business
20 in compliance with applicable State and local law
21 with any person not a licensee at any location at
22 which the licensee may conduct business under this
23 chapter.”.
