A BILL

To prohibit the Administrator of the Environmental Protection Agency from awarding any grant, contract, cooperative agreement, or other financial assistance under section 103 of the Clean Air Act for any program, project, or activity outside the United States.

3 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4 This Act may be cited as the “Accountability in
5 Grants Act of 2013”.

1 **SEC. 2. PROHIBITION AGAINST FUNDING CERTAIN FOR-**
2 **EIGN PROGRAMS, PROJECTS, AND ACTIVI-**
3 **TIES.**

4 Section 103 of the Clean Air Act (42 U.S.C. 7403)
5 is amended by adding at the end the following:

6 “(1) PROHIBITION AGAINST FUNDING FOREIGN PRO-
7 GRAMS, PROJECTS, AND ACTIVITIES.—The Administrator
8 shall not award any grant, contract, cooperative agree-
9 ment, or other financial assistance under this section for
10 any program, project, or activity that will be carried out
11 outside the United States or the territories and posses-
12 sions of the United States.”.
