To amend the Wild and Scenic Rivers Act to designate a segment of Illabot Creek in Skagit County, Washington, as a component of the National Wild and Scenic Rivers System.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. DESIGNATION OF WILD AND SCENIC RIVER**

4 **SEGMENTS.**

5 Section 3(a) of the Wild and Scenic Rivers Act (16

6 U.S.C. 1274(a)) is amended by adding at the end the fol-

7 lowing:

1 “(_____) ILLABOT CREEK, WASHINGTON.—The
2 14.3 mile segment from the headwaters of Illabot
3 Creek to 1,000 feet south of and at no point closer
4 than 200 feet from the Rockport-Cascade Road,
5 flowing through lands managed by the U.S. Forest
6 Service, Washington State Department of Natural
7 Resources, and Seattle City Light, to be adminis-
8 tered by the Secretary of Agriculture as follows:

9 “(A) The 4.3 mile segment from the head-
10 waters of Illabot Creek to the boundary of Gla-
11 cier Peak Wilderness Area as a wild river.

12 “(B) The 10 mile segment from the bound-
13 ary of Glacier Peak Wilderness to 1,000 feet
14 south of Rockport-Cascade Road as a rec-
15 reational river.”.
