## A BILL

To designate the facility of the United States Postal Service located at 95 Dogwood Street in Cary, Mississippi, as the “Spencer Byrd Powers, Jr. Post Office”.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*  
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. SPENCER BYRD POWERS, JR. POST OFFICE.**

4 (a) DESIGNATION.—The facility of the United States  
5 Postal Service located at 95 Dogwood Street in Cary, Mis-  
6 sissippi, shall be known and designated as the “Spencer  
7 Byrd Powers, Jr. Post Office”.

8 (b) REFERENCES.—Any reference in a law, map, reg-  
9 ulation, document, paper, or other record of the United

1 States to the facility referred to in subsection (a) shall  
2 be deemed to be a reference to the “Spencer Byrd Powers,  
3 Jr. Post Office”.
