3 **SECTION 1. SPENCER BYRD POWERS, JR. POST OFFICE.**

4 (a) DESIGNATION.—The facility of the United States
5 Postal Service located at 95 Dogwood Street in Cary, Mis-

1 sissippi, shall be known and designated as the “Spencer
2 Byrd Powers, Jr. Post Office”.

3 (b) REFERENCES.—Any reference in a law, map, reg-
4 ulation, document, paper, or other record of the United
5 States to the facility referred to in subsection (a) shall
6 be deemed to be a reference to the “Spencer Byrd Powers,
7 Jr. Post Office”.
