Mr. THUNE (for himself and Mr. GRAHAM) introduced the following bill; which
was read twice and referred to the Committee on Finance

A BILL

To repeal the CLASS program.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4 This Act may be cited as the “Repeal the CLASS
5 Entitlement Act”.

6 **SEC. 2. REPEAL OF CLASS PROGRAM.**

7 (a) REPEAL.—Title XXXII of the Public Health
8 Service Act (42 U.S.C. 30011 et seq.; relating to the
9 CLASS program) is repealed.

10 (b) CONFORMING CHANGES.—

1 (1) Title VIII of the Patient Protection and Af-
2 fordable Care Act (Public Law 111–148; 124 Stat.
3 119, 846–847) is repealed.

4 (2) Section 1902(a) of the Social Security Act
5 (42 U.S.C. 1396a(a)) is amended—

6 (A) by striking paragraphs (81) and (82);

7 (B) in paragraph (80), by inserting “and”
8 at the end; and

9 (C) by redesignating paragraph (83) as
10 paragraph (81).

11 (3) Paragraphs (2) and (3) of section 6021(d)
12 of the Deficit Reduction Act of 2005 (42 U.S.C.
13 1396p note) are amended to read as such para-
14 graphs were in effect on the day before the date of
15 the enactment of section 8002(d) of the Patient Pro-
16 tection and Affordable Care Act (Public Law 111–
17 148). Of the funds appropriated by paragraph (3) of
18 such section 6021(d), as amended by the Patient
19 Protection and Affordable Care Act, the unobligated
20 balance is rescinded.

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
