3 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4 This Act may be cited as the “Indian School Bus
5 Route Safety Reauthorization Act of 2009”.

1 **SEC. 2. REAUTHORIZATION OF ADDITIONAL CONTRACT AU-**
2 **THORITY FOR STATES WITH INDIAN RES-**
3 **ERVATIONS.**

4 Section 1214(d)(5)(A) of the Transportation Equity
5 Act for the 21st Century (23 U.S.C. 202 note; 112 Stat.
6 206; 119 Stat. 1460) is amended by striking “\$1,800,000
7 for each of fiscal years 2005 through 2009” and inserting
8 “\$2,000,000 for each of fiscal years 2010 through 2015”.

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
