A BILL

To repeal title IV of the Economic Growth, Regulatory Relief, and Consumer Protection Act.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4 This Act may be cited as the “Secure Viable Banking
5 Act” or the “SVB Act”.

6 **SEC. 2. RESTORATION OF BANKING REGULATIONS.**

7 Title IV of the Economic Growth, Regulatory Relief,
8 and Consumer Protection Act (Public Law 115–174; 132

1 Stat. 1296) is repealed, and the provisions of law amended
2 by that title are restored as if that title had not been en-
3 acted.
