A BILL

To amend title 38, United States Code, to extend to all veterans with a serious service-connected injury eligibility to participate in the family caregiver services program.

2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4 This Act may be cited as the “Caregivers Expansion
5 and Improvement Act of 2013”.

1 **SEC. 2. EXTENSION TO ALL VETERANS WITH A SERIOUS**
2 **SERVICE-CONNECTED DISABILITY OF ELIGI-**
3 **BILITY FOR PARTICIPATION IN FAMILY CARE-**
4 **GIVER PROGRAM.**

5 Section 1720G(a)(2)(B) of title 38, United States
6 Code, is amended by striking “on or after September 11,
7 2001”.
