3 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4 This Act may be cited as the “American Economic
5 Diplomacy Act”.

1 **SEC. 2. MODIFICATION TO ANNUAL REPORT ON TRADE**
2 **AGREEMENTS PROGRAM AND NATIONAL**
3 **TRADE POLICY AGENDA.**

4 Section 163(a)(3)(A) of the Trade Act of 1974 (19
5 U.S.C. 2213(a)(3)(A)) is amended—

6 (1) by redesignating clause (iv) as clause (v);

7 (2) in clause (iii), by striking “and” at the end;

8 and

9 (3) by inserting after clause (iii) the following:

10 “(iv) how such objectives and priorities
11 support and advance the objectives of—

12 “(I) the national defense strategy
13 under 113(g) of title 10, United States
14 Code; and

15 “(II) the national security strategy of
16 the United States under section 108 of the
17 National Security Act of 1947 (50 U.S.C.
18 3043); and”.
