## A BILL

To provide for the extension of a certain hydroelectric project located in the State of West Virginia.

- 1 Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-
- 2 tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,
- 3 SECTION 1. EXTENSION OF DEADLINE TO COMMENCE CON-
- 4 STRUCTION.
- 5 (a) In General.—Notwithstanding the period speci-
- 6 fied in section 13 of the Federal Power Act (16 U.S.C.
- 7 806) that would otherwise apply to Federal Energy Regu-
- 8 latory Commission project number 9042, the Federal En-
- 9 ergy Regulatory Commission (referred to in this Act as
- 10 the "Commission") shall, on the request of the licensee

- 1 of that project, and in accordance with the good faith, due
- 2 diligence, and public interest requirements of, the proce-
- 3 dures of the Commission under, and other procedures
- 4 specified in, that section, extend the deadline by which the
- 5 licensee is required to commence construction of the
- 6 project to the date that is 2 years after the date of enact-
- 7 ment of this Act.
- 8 (b) Applicability.—Subsection (a) shall take effect
- 9 with respect to the project described in that subsection
- 10 on expiration of the extension, issued by the Commission
- 11 under section 13 of the Federal Power Act (16 U.S.C.
- 12 806), of the period for the commencement of construction
- 13 of the project.
- 14 (c) Reinstatement of Expired License.—If a li-
- 15 cense for the project described in subsection (a) expires
- 16 before the date of enactment of this Act, the Commission
- 17 shall—
- 18 (1) reinstate the license, effective as of that
- date of expiration; and
- 20 (2) extend the deadline by which the licensee of
- 21 the project is required to commence construction of
- 22 the project to the date that is 2 years after the date
- of enactment of this Act.

#### 1 SEC. 2. EXTENSION OF LICENSE PERIOD.

- 2 Notwithstanding the period of a license specified in
- 3 section 6 of the Federal Power Act (16 U.S.C. 799) that
- 4 would otherwise apply to the project described in section
- 5 1(a), the Commission shall, on the request of the licensee
- 6 of that project, and in accordance with such terms and
- 7 conditions of that Act (16 U.S.C. 791a et seq.) and the
- 8 Commission as are applicable to the project and the li-
- 9 cense, extend the period of the license to 70 years, as cal-
- 10 culated beginning on the date identified in the original
- 11 order of the Commission issuing the license for the project.
