A BILL

To amend title 4, United States Code, to declare English as the national language of the Government of the United States, and for other purposes.

- 1 Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-
- 2 tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,
- 3 SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.
- 4 This Act may be cited as the "National Language
- 5 Act of 2009".
- 6 SEC. 2. AMENDMENT TO TITLE 4.
- 7 (a) In General.—Title 4, United States Code, is
- 8 amended by adding at the end the following:

"CHAPTER 6—LANGUAGE OF THE

- 8 "(a) In General.—The Government of the United
- 9 States shall preserve and enhance the role of English as
- 10 the national language of the United States of America.
- 11 "(b) Exception.—Unless specifically provided by
- 12 statute, no person has a right, entitlement, or claim to
- 13 have the Government of the United States or any of its
- 14 officials or representatives act, communicate, perform or
- 15 provide services, or provide materials in any language
- 16 other than English. If an exception is made with respect
- 17 to the use of a language other than English, the exception
- 18 does not create a legal entitlement to additional services
- 19 in that language or any language other than English.
- 20 "(c) Forms.—If any form is issued by the Federal
- 21 Government in a language other than English (or such
- 22 form is completed in a language other than English), the

- English language version of the form is the sole authority
 for all legal purposes.
